## ARRIVE / SETTLE / CONNECT

## LEARN / ENGAGE / DINE



After breakfast we embark on a guided walking tour through San Pancho ending up at the amazing facility of Entreamigos, our community partner. Enjoy a ceviche lunch with their team leaders and then spend the afternoon engaging with youth or women involved in their high-impact programs. The evening will include a tequila tasting before heading off to taste some local cuisine at an authentic taqueria.

## BREATHE / DEVELOP / CELEBRATE



Enjoy optional activities like beach yoga or a beach run, or simply take this time to explore San Pancho a bit on your own. Spend the morning at Entreamigos for further engagement with the women entrepreneurs and do a bit of shopping at the gallery, where they sell their artisan crafts. Return to the hotel for lunch and a quick change- this afternoon we will be doing a hike to a local beach. Finish the day with a chef-curated, farm to table meal that you won't forget! Extend your evening with optional late night drinks and live music in town.
